Our Health + Safety QR Code Site Register Guide



Step 1: Create a Google Form (The Check-In Page)

Instead of linking the QR code to a blank page, you link it to a quick form.

- 1 Go to Google Forms (free with any Google/Gmail account) and create a new form titled something like "Site Health & Safety Check-In".
- 2 Add a question: "What is your name?" (Set as a dropdown list with all the boys' names, or a short answer text box).
- 3 Add a question: "Which worksite are you on?" (Dropdown list of your active sites). **You can also skip this if you're making a QR each individual site.**
- 4 Add a checkbox question: "I acknowledge and agree to the health and safety rules of this site for May 27, 2026." (Make this required) You can hyperlink to a PDF of the rules and regs.
- 5 Go to the Responses tab at the top and click "Link to Sheets". This creates a live spreadsheet that automatically logs the exact date and time (timestamp) the second they hit submit.

Step 2: Generate the QR Code

- 1 Click Send on your Google Form, copy the link (URL).
- 2 Go to a free QR Code maker - I use QRCode Monkey.
- 3 Paste your Google Form link, download the QR code image, and add to a poster you've made on Canva, or print it out on a piece of paper or card to laminate for the site.
